Regular Monthly Meeting

Wednesday April 3, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Richard R. Hess, Chair, at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard R. Hess, Dennis Sheatler and William Hartman. Roadmaster Frank Rishel and 6 visitors.

All motions are approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 6, 2019 monthly meeting. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for March. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve payment of the bills for April. Second William Hartman.

William Hartman made a motion to approve the minutes of the special meeting for March 13, 2019. Second Richard Hess.

William Hartman made a motion to approve the work session minutes for March 26, 2019. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Old Business:

There were two zoning permits issued in March for a total of \$160.00.

Roadmaster Frank Rishel presented a report on the road work done in March.

Solicitor Voelcker reported on the Nonemaker issue.

Stone bids were opened and read. Richard Hess made a motion to award 500 ton 1B stone and 500 ton 2RC Modified to New Enterprise and 1,200 ton 2B (#57); 250 ton #4 stone (Aashto #1); 500 ton Gabion; 3,800 ton 2A Subbase; 250 ton R5/R6 RipRap and 1,000 ton R8 RipRap to Hanson Aggregates. Second Dennis Sheatler.

New Business:

Richard Hess made a motion approve the spring Newsletter as submitted. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Dennis Sheatler made a motion to put roadwork out for bid for 2019—approximately 66,878 SY of bituminous Seal coat single application & approximately 5,595 SY of Bituminous Seal Coat double application—to be opened and awarded at the May 1, 2019 meeting at 7PM. Second William Hartman.

Discussed the Dirt & Gravel road grant. Richard Hess made a motion to move forward to apply for the grant for the road or roads that are recommended by Tyler Servose. Second William Hartman.

Reviewed the letter from Lewis Township requesting financial assistance for their recycling program. Dennis Sheatler suggested contacting the county Commissioners to see if they are willing to help with this cost. Dennis will contact them and report on his findings at the next meeting.

The Open Space-Sub applicant Maintenance Agreement Certification and the letter to PEMA agreeing to comply with all permits, codes and regulations we reviewed. After some discussion, Richard Hess made a motion to approve both letters upon approval of our Solicitor. Second William Hartman.

Reviewed email from Tyler Dombroski from SEDA-COG concerning the property on Fox Hollow Road that is not eligible for acquisition. The board will review it and discuss it at a future meeting.

Public Comment: Jack Kirkner questioned an area on School House Lane that needs repaired. Frank will take a look at it.

There being no further official business Richard Hess made a motion to adjourn at 7:45 PM. Second Dennis Sheatler.
