

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Regular Monthly Meeting
Wednesday May 1, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Richard R. Hess, Chair, at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard R. Hess, Dennis Sheatler and William Hartman. Solicitor Laurinda Voelcker, Roadmaster Frank Rishel and 7 visitors.

All motions are approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 3, 2019 monthly meeting. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for April. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve payment of the bills for May. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the work session minutes for April 23, 2019. Second William Hartman.

Old Business:

There were three zoning permits issued in April for a total of \$700.00.

Roadmaster Frank Rishel presented a report on the road work done in April.

Seal Coat bids were opened and read. Hammaker East, LTD total bid was \$105,890.11; Midland Asphalt Materials, Inc. total bid was \$109,066.16. Richard Hess made a motion to award the contract to Hammaker East, LTD for a total cost of \$105,890.11. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Solicitor Voelcker reported on the Nonemaker issue. A Predisposition conference has been set for Thursday June 20, 2019 at 9:30 AM at Columbia County Courthouse. The reason for conference is because sanctions are being imposed on Lottie Nonemaker. Laurinda requested a supervisor be in attendance. Richard Hess agreed to be in attendance. Sewage Enforcement Officer, James Sanders, will be in attendance as well.

New Business:

A letter addressed to Madison Township was read to the audience requesting reimbursement for one of our workers doing work for them during the storm event of April 15, 2019. Dennis Sheatler made a motion to send the letter as submitted. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to allow Frank Rishel and Jason Trauger to attend the 20th annual west branch COG equipment show and training day on Wednesday May 22, 2019 from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm at the Lycoming county fairgrounds. Second William Hartman.

Penny updated the board on FEMA—the site inspector will be meeting with Frank and Penny to look at the damage on North Sneaky Hollow Road. The township will be repairing that road and requesting reimbursement because it was damaged during the flood of August 2018.

Richard Hess reported that the township received a response from Senator Gordner concerning the State Police Fees for municipalities without a township police force. Senator Gordner reported that he too is not in favor of the proposal.

Richard Hess reported that Greg Molter, Director of Planning, met with the board to let them know of changes that are being considered by the county to make changes to the current zoning ordinance. Six residents purchased property from Talen. After purchase, it was brought to their attention that their property was zoned Public/Semi-Public which means they cannot reside on the property. These property owners are requesting a change to the zoning so that they can reside on their land. The county is considering changing all of the Talen property so that an owner can reside on it. Except the property that is located at the PPL Lake and surrounding acres that will remain as is. There will be an advertised public meeting before any changes will be made. The township will keep the people informed as information comes in.
