

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Regular Monthly Meeting

Wednesday June 2, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Richard R. Hess, Chair, at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard R. Hess, Dennis Sheatler, William Hartman, Roadmaster Frank Rishel and 10 visitors.

Pledge to flag and remain Standing for Prayer.

All motions are approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 5, 2021 monthly meeting. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for May. Second William Hartman. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken

Richard Hess made a motion to approve payment of the bills for June 2021. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken

Old Business:

Roadmaster Frank Rishel presented a report, which was made available to all those in attendance, on the road work done in May.

Penny Rishel read the zoning report to the audience. There were 2 approved zoning permits for a total of \$350.00 for the month of May.

Penny reported that Central Keystone COG sent a report for the first quarter of 2021. One permit was issued. Penny will ask the COG to give more information in the future.

Reviewed Application for Blanket Accident Insurance. Policy is for 7/30/2021 to 7/30/2022. This insurance is for volunteers that we discussed in a previous meeting. Richard Hess made a motion to approve the insurance policy. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

The board of Supervisors reviewed the quotes (4) for paving work on two roads:

- Shetler Road—Mill tie-ins at each end of patch. Repair ditch line at road pipe with 3" of 19mm. Scratch coat a leveling course. Overlay approximately 136' x 9' area with 2" of 19mm.
- Gearhart Road—Mill and remove materials in 3 areas and replace with 4" of 19mm (9' x 19') (15' x 22') (7' x 22').

Quotes: Stix N Stonz--\$17,500; All Excavating--\$19,000; Richard M. Wells & Son--\$17,000; Fairchild Brothers (FBI)--\$16,265.00

Richard Hess made a motion to accept the low bid of \$16,265 from Fairchild Brothers. Second William Hartman. Richard Hess asked if there were any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

New Business:

Frank Rishel reported that there was damage done to the tar and chipping on Foggy Mountain Road on the section from White Hall Road to Fox Hollow Road. There were two areas that were damaged. The approximate size of the areas are 3' x 1.5' and 20' x 13'. Frank believes that he knows who did the damage but there are not any witnesses to testify to the damage. The road will need repair. There are two different options for repair. The first is to fill both areas in with cold patch and the second is to cut out the damaged areas. Make a change order to the Tar and Chip contract and have Russell Standard apply a double application to both areas. Richard Hess made a motion to allow Frank to move forward to repair the road as necessary. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken.

Reviewed a document that the township received from Emergency Management Coordinator, Ed Burkland, for the 2021 Montour County Revised Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)—Resolution #6 of 2021. After review, Dennis Sheatler made a motion to adopt the Resolution. Second William Hartman. Richard Hess asked if there were any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

Reviewed the electric quotes (2) to run four dedicated 120 volt outlets to each garage door location for the new openers to plug into. I Ray Zimmerman--\$1,000; AMK Electric—Jeff Kline--\$1,447.00. Richard Hess made a motion to accept the quote from I Ray Zimmerman of \$1,000. Second William Hartman. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken.

Received a call from the NCTCC (Northumberland County Tax Collection Committee) secretary Lucinda Bomberger. She said that if we are not going to be able to attend the meetings then we need to update our proxy vote. Penny called Turbotville Borough and Christina Mensch, President of the Borough, is willing to fill that position for Anthony Township. Richard Hess made a motion to send a letter to Turbotville Borough appointing Christina Mensch as our proxy vote. Second William Hartman. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken.

Penny Rishel asked for permission to apply for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds and to apply the money to the account or open a 12 month CD depending on where the township can receive the best interest. Richard Hess made a motion to allow Penny to apply for the funds and to put the township's funds in whatever account with give the best interest rate. Second William Hartman. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken.

Richard Hess read an email that the township received from Greg Molter concerning the Montour Solar 1 Project. "The zoning committee has concluded its work to their satisfaction. The Draft will be presented to the planning commission June 16th. If they approve, it will be presented to the county commissioners and the municipalities for supervisor and resident's review. The county commissioner will then schedule a public hearing to address the amendment and hear public testimony."

Public Comment: Richard Hess asked for any public comment. There were none.

There being no other official business to conduct, Dennis Sheatler made a motion to adjourn. Second William Hartman.
