

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Regular Monthly Meeting

Wednesday June 5, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Richard R. Hess, Chair, at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard R. Hess, Dennis Sheatler and William Hartman. Solicitor Laurinda Voelcker, Roadmaster Frank Rishel and 9 visitors.

All motions are approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 1, 2019 monthly meeting. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for May. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve payment of the bills for June. Second William Hartman.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the special meeting minutes for May 9, 2019. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the work session minutes for May 28, 2019. Second William Hartman. Vote 2 yea. (Dennis Sheatler was not in attendance).

Old Business:

There was one zoning permits issued in May for a total of \$55.00.

Roadmaster Frank Rishel presented a report on the road work done in May.

The board decided to table the awarding of the contract until the low bidder could be contacted to review the Erosion & Sedimentation plan for the project. A decision will be made at the work session meeting on Tuesday June 25, 2019.

New Business:

Craig High, a resident from PPL Farm Road, asked the board to reconsider vacating PPL Farm Road where his family resides. After much discussion from both Mr. High and the board it was decided to keep the road open to the public as it is.

Reviewed the letter from Commissioners of Montour County concerning the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for property acquisition for the home located on Fox Hollow Road (Bertha & Vance Harris) that was not eligible through FEMA because it is not in the flood zone. If interested in applying for the grant then someone needs to attend the meeting on Wednesday June 26, 2019 at 6:30 PM at the courthouse. Dennis Sheatler asked Penny to contact the Harris family to make sure that they are interested in acquisitioning their home. Richard Hess made a motion to allow Penny to attend the meeting if the Harris's are in favor of it. Second Dennis Sheatler.

Reviewed the letter from U.S. Census Bureau asking the township if they are interested in the 2020 Census New Construction Program. After reviewing the letter and brochure, Richard Hess made a motion to send the form back and NOT participating in the program. Second William Hartman.

Reviewed the job application for Jedidiah Rishel. He was in attendance and some questions were asked of him by the board. Richard Hess made a motion to hire Jedidiah Rishel as a part-time laborer on an as needed basis at a rate of \$10.30/hour (the same rate as Darren Brown). Second Dennis Sheatler.

Penny Rishel reported that she is requesting a reimbursement from FEMA in the amount of \$64,601.94 for the work that was already completed on township roads during the flood of August 2018.
