

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Regular Monthly Meeting
Wednesday September 1, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Richard R. Hess, Chair, at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard R. Hess, Dennis Sheatler and Gary Fogelman. Roadmaster Frank Rishel and 7 visitors.

Pledge to flag and remain Standing for Prayer.

All motions are approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 4, 2021 monthly meeting. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report for August. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve payment of the bills for September 2021. Second Gary Fogelman. Richard Hess asked for any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

Richard Hess made a motion to approve the work session minutes of August 24, 2021 meeting. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken.

Old Business:

Penny Rishel read the zoning report to the audience. There were 3 approved zoning permits for a total of \$1,165.00 for the month of August.

Penny reported that Central Keystone COG sent a report for August 2021—2 permits were issued.

Roadmaster Frank Rishel presented a report, which was made available to all those in attendance, on the road work done in August.

Frank Rishel reported on an update on the Larson Road Grant Project. Recon Construction provided a tentative work schedule and a letter of notice to residents of Larson Road to the township. Frank reported that he hand delivered the letters to all of the residents on Larson Road. The road will be closed to all people who do not live on Larson. Also, Watson Excavating has been hired as a sub-contractor to take care of the pipe replacement.

A resident entered a complaint concerning a neighbor on Muncy Exchange Road. The board asked Penny to send Central Keystone COG pictures of the property to ask them for advice.

The township received a letter from Mr. & Mrs. James Holdren of Preserve Road. Richard Hess asked Penny to read the letter to the audience.

New Business:

The board discussed adding an additional sentence to the last paragraph of the form letter for the "Property Maintenance Code Violation". After some discussion the following sentence will be added to the letter "*If violations are found by KCOG the landowner will be responsible for any expenses incurred to the township.*" Richard Hess made a motion to approve the addition. Second Gary Fogelman. Richard Hess asked if there were any comments or questions. There being none, vote was taken.

Montour County's One Hundred and Eighth Annual Township Officials Convention will be held Thursday, October 21, 2021 at the Montour DeLong Fair building in Washingtonville. Registration at 5:15 and dinner at 6:15. Cost of dinner is \$16/person. Richard Hess made a motion to pay for the township officials or employees who want to attend. Second Dennis Sheatler.
