

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Work Session Meeting

Tuesday April 23, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Richard Hess, Chair, at 6:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard Hess, Dennis Sheatler, William Hartman and Roadmaster Frank Rishel. No visitors.

Reviewed email from Laurinda Voelcker concerning hearing for Lottie Nonemaker for Thursday June 20, 2019 at 9:30 AM at Columbia County courthouse. Tabled discussion until May 1, 2019 meeting when Solicitor Voelcker will be in attendance.

Discussed participation in the recycling program with Lewis Township. The Montour County Commissioners have voted to donate up to \$1,000 for this year to help with the cost of the program. Dennis Sheatler made a motion to donate \$125 to the Montour County Commissioners to help to cover the cost. Second William Hartman. Vote 3 yea.

There will be a FEMA meeting with Kevin Walters, Hazard Mitigation Floodplain Specialist, on Thursday May 16, 2019 at 10AM. Richard Hess and Penny Rishel will attend the meeting.

During the most recent storm on April 14 – 15 Terry Rider, Madison Township Supervisor called Frank Rishel to ask for assistance since Terry and the other supervisor, Dale Titman was in Hershey at the convention and their township had severe damage and several roads were not passable due to down trees. He agreed to reimburse the township for any time and equipment that is used. Frank reported that he worked for 2.5 hours and used our townships truck and saws. Richard Hess made a motion to have the secretary invoice Madison Township for costs that Anthony Township incurred. Second Dennis Sheatler. Vote 3 yea.

Penny reported that the solar panels (12 in the middle) are not reporting their input on the website. Third Sun Solar was contacted and they will be here to repair the panels the beginning of May.

Reviewed request for payment for May.

The board of supervisors discussed attendance of the Solicitor at our monthly meetings. Dennis Sheatler made a motion to have attendance at a meeting on an as needed basis. Continue to send all of the meeting agenda and minutes and any other information to keep her updated. Second Richard Hess. Vote 3 yea.
