

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Work Session Meeting

Tuesday July 27, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Richard Hess-Chair, at 6:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard Hess, Gary Fogelman and Dennis Sheatler and Roadmaster Frank Rishel.

Yeagle Road was damaged due to the contractor, Pave It, Inc. by using their equipment to pave a driveway and they entered onto the township road and caused damage to an area 196' x 19'. Russell Standard was awarded the seal coat bid in our township and they are willing to add that section of Yeagle Road to the contract and do a single application of seal coat. This cost will be approximately \$500.00. Richard Hess made a motion to send a bill to Pave It, Inc. after the work is done. Second Dennis Sheatler. Vote was taken. 3 yea.

Frank reported that the resident on Sportsman Road moved his fence out of the township right of way but he has not had the opportunity to check on the one on Crawford Road.

In 2020, permits to install pipes along Foggy Mountain Road were purchased by a property owner. These pipes have not yet been installed. Dennis Sheatler made a motion to have the secretary write a letter to this resident to have the pipes installed before harvest season. Second Richard Hess. Vote 3 yea.

Received a letter from Leena Bruch's (Clarence Bruch's widow) concerning a letter about cleaning up the property at 4830 Muncy Exchange Road. Reviewed the letter and tabled it until further information is gathered.

An application for employment was received from a local resident. The township will contact him and see if he is still interested in the position and tell him the job description and the pay rate and report back after contacting him.

Reviewed request for payment for August.

No public comment.

There being no further official business, Dennis Sheatler made a motion to adjourn at 6:35 PM. Second Richard Hess. Vote 3 yea.
