

## **ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS**

Work Session Meeting  
Tuesday August 24, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Richard Hess-Chair, at 6:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard Hess, Gary Fogelman and Dennis Sheatler and Roadmaster Frank Rishel and one visitor.

Discussed the repairs that were done to Yeagle Road where Pave It, Inc. did the damage. Richard Hess made a motion to have Solicitor Laurinda Voelcker write a letter to them requesting that they pay for the damage. Second Dennis Sheatler. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken. Vote 3 yea.

Discussed the purchase of new computer for the office. Mike Jensen, of Computer Connections tried to upgrade the recent computer but it is too old to upgrade. Cost of a new one would be approximately \$759 plus service call. This cost will come out of the Liquid Fuels account. Gary Fogelman made a motion to purchase the new computer. Second Richard Hess. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken. Vote 3 yea.

Discussed the need for updated radios in the township trucks. The ones that are now being used are ten years old and are out of date. Keystone Communications has been contacted. They estimated that the township needs approximately four new radios. Three for the trucks and one in the office. The cost will be approximately \$5,000 to \$7,000 depending on the total number of radios, antennae's and labor. This money can also be used out of the Liquid Fuels money. Richard Hess made a motion to purchase as many radios as needed and to make sure that the current ones are compatible with the new ones. If not then more will be purchased. Second Gary Fogelman. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or concerns. There being none, vote was taken. Vote 3 yea.

Discussed the Property Maintenance violation letters. They will all be reviewed in September.

Received a complaint from a resident concerning a property on Muncy Exchange Road. After reviewing the pictures and the ordinance the board of supervisors did not find any violation.

Discussed the meeting with RK Webster and Recon concerning the Larson Road Grant Project. Received a copy of the tentative schedule and the letter that will be delivered to all of the residents along Larson Road.

Penny reported on the Regional Forum training that she attended on Thursday August 5, 2021 at the Holiday Inn in Williamsport.

Received a request from Lisa Hartman, President of the Exchange Pool asking to be considered to receive funds from the Cares Act for replacement of the kiddie pool. SEDA-COG is forming a committee to help municipalities figure out how to disperse the monies. Penny will contact Lisa to let her know this.

Frank reported that a resident on Magargle Road placed cement on the entrance to his driveway and it is in the township's right-of-way. The cement is higher than the road and he is concerned that the plows will catch it in the winter and cause damage to the equipment. Dennis Sheatler made a motion to send a letter to the resident asking him to remove the cement out of the right of way. Second Richard Hess. Richard Hess asked if there were any questions or comments. There being none, vote was taken. Vote 3 yea.

Reviewed request for payment for September.

No public comment.

There being no further official business, Dennis Sheatler made a motion to adjourn at 7:05PM. Second Richard Hess. Vote 3 yea.
