

ANTHONY TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Work Session Meeting
Tuesday August 27, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Richard Hess, Chair, at 6:00 P.M. In attendance were Supervisors Richard Hess, William Hartman and Roadmaster Frank Rishel. Dennis Sheatler was absent. No visitors.

William Hartman reported on the meeting that was held on August 13, 2019 at 11:05 at the courthouse concerning the amendment to the zoning ordinance for Talen properties in Anthony Township. Penny will contact Planning Commission Director, Greg Molter, and report on it at the September meeting,

Richard Hess is still working on the issue with the solar panels. He will report on it further at the September meeting.

Kelly Newman, of Shetler Road, has requested a "granny flat" be added to her property. The request has been granted by the Zoning Variance board with the stipulation that an agreement be drawn up between Ms. Newman and Anthony Township. Richard Hess made a motion to ask Solicitor Laurinda Voelcker to compose an agreement. Second William Hartman. Vote 2 yea.

Frank discussed the condition of the 90 GMC with the board. It will not go into reverse and the motor needs new injectors and bushings. The estimated cost to repair it is between \$4,000 and \$5,000. His suggestion is that we scrap it and take all of the parts off of it that can be used on our other equipment. The board will discuss it further when Dennis Sheatler is in attendance and Penny will have the maintenance records available for the board at that time.

Frank reported that on Gearhart Road there is quite a bit of brush lying in the stream and along the streambank. He is concerned that if a large amount of rain falls the culvert will be blocked once again causing flooding and damage. Richard Hess asked Frank to contact Tyler at Soil and Conservation to see if there is anything that they can do about the problem. It will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Stamm road is completed. Penny will be sending in the paperwork to the Multimodal Transportation Fund to request the payment of \$155,473.00 to the township.

The power lines at the Randy Michaels property at the end of North Sneaky Hollow Road have been raised to the 16' height as requested.

N. Sneaky Hollow Road Rock Embankment project will be started on Tuesday September 3, 2019.

Reviewed request for payment for September.

No public comment.

There being no further official business. Richard Hess made a motion to adjourn at 7:35 PM. Second William Hartman.
