Work Session Meeting

Tuesday September 28, 2021

The board discussed the four letters that were sent to residents who violated the Property Maintenance Ordinance. All four residents had 60 days to respond to the violation. Penny will contact the CKCOG with all of the information.

The township sent pictures to the Central Keystone COG concerning the property on Muncy Exchange Road for advice. They suggested sending a letter to the property owner concerning the violation. Richard Hess made a motion to send the letter. Second Gary Fogelman. Vote 3 yea.

It was brought to the boards' attention that a resident took some materials from the stockpile. Supervisor Hess discussed this with the resident. Richard Hess made a motion to have the Solicitor send a letter to the resident concerning the violation. Second Gary Fogelman. Vote 3 yea.

Reviewed request for payment for October.

There being no further official business, Dennis Sheatler made a motion to adjourn at 7:05PM. Second Richard Hess. Vote 3 yea.
